General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, all classes were having quiet time. The 4-year-old class was upstairs in the gym playing as the younger classes were resting downstairs. In the gym, the children were observed playing with balls, singing songs and riding on plasma cars. The children's water bottles were brought upstairs while the children played.

Downstairs, the classes slowly started to transition from nap time to afternoon snack. As the children woke up, cots were sanitized, and the children went to the washroom to washed hands for afternoon snack. Gentle reminders were heard during this time, encouraging the children to use their walking feet when walking in the hallway. The Educators were observed sitting with the children during snack, engaged in conversation. As the children finished afternoon snack, sunscreen was applied before the children lined up to go outside. A headcount was observed as the children entered the fenced in playground. The outdoor play area offers a variety of materials for the children to use. Small groups were observed using shovels, buckets and trucks in the sandbox while others played on the play structure, using the slide and swing set.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were attentive to the needs of the children and were observed supporting the children while encouraging independence.
