<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the classes were finishing up quiet time and preparing to have afternoon snack. The indoor environment was tidy, well organized and welcoming. Collaborative artwork, current learning stories and daily planning was observed in the classrooms and displayed outside the rooms in the hallway. Each room offered a variety of play materials such as books, building blocks, plastic animals, cars, busy boards and musical instruments on low open shelves to ensure materials were accessible. The materials observed were in good condition.</p> <p>Hand washing was observed in the Senior Infant classroom before they sat to eat. As the infants finished eating, one Educator was observed wiping their hands and faces with a warm cloth. Once all infants had finished eating, tables were sanitized and floors were swept. The infants played with large foam blocks and cars as they waited to get muddy buddies and boots on. The Educators held hands with the infants as they transitioned from the indoor environment to outside to ensure the safety of the group, especially as they walked across the parking lot.</p> <p>With the change in weather, spring toys have been added to the outdoor play space. A large group of children were observed playing in the sandbox. The children used shovels, bowls and buckets to scoop and pouring the sand. One group in particular used a large shovel to scoop the sand and dump it, laughing as this process created "smoke" dust. Other children were observed sitting together on a wooden swing, rocking back and forth with others climbing a play structure. Gentle reminders to go feet first down the slide were heard. All groups were observed having outdoor play time.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed today. The Educators spoke kindly and respectfully with the children and other Educators. Staff files were reviewed for a new Educator who was on site. All required documents were present in the staff file. Families were greeted as the children got picked up at the end of the day and attendance records were updated.</p>
