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General Comments Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct the Renewal Inspection. At the time of arrival, the group was outside for the morning drop-off period. Children were actively engaged in a range of activities, including playing catch, participating in board games at a picnic table, and taking part in a group game of "Man Hunter." As children arrived throughout the morning, the Educators updated attendance records and communicated with one another to verify the number of children present. One Educator explained some children bike to the facility. To provide a safe riding area, educators had sectioned off a portion of the parking lot using orange safety cones, giving the children the opportunity to use their bike during outdoor time. Before transitioning indoors, the Educators provided the children with a 10-minute verbal warning. The children lined up beside the building with their backpacks and water bottles, and a headcount was observed prior to entering the facility. After washing their hands, the children sat down to have morning snack. Once snack was finished, some children chose to play basketball in the gym while others remained in the classroom playing card games. One Educator stayed in the classroom while another stayed in the gym to ensure proper supervision. With rain expected later in the day, the group cleaned up after snack and returned outdoors to play before lunch. Positive child guidance was observed throughout the inspection. Educators engaged in conversations with the children, joining them in activities such as playing catch and participating in active games. An Educator showed Licensing Staff a large binder they have created throughout the year. The binder was full of pictures and activities the group have done throughout the past year. Pictures were also posted throughout the classroom. A review of staff and children's files confirmed they were in compliance with licensing requirements, and documentation verified that monthly fire drills are being completed as required. Licensing Staff recommends for Renewal.
