## General Comments

Educators have continued to work on the space adding different elements. Rooms are organized with many age-appropriate materials. A well-stocked science centre, art areas and a dramatic play space with play food, dishes and accessories have been redesigned.

Artwork, photos, and other forms of documentation are posted. The front porch has a "What We're Up To" display that shows activities and evidence of planned programming. Recent field trips have been to the Quartermain Earth Science Centre, The Military Museum, the Fredericton Public Library, Pine Grove Nursing Home, and Oromocto Ceramics Club. March Break included painting on canvas, a movie day, and guided meditation.

Cleaning checklists, fire drill records, and outdoor maintenance logs have been completed each month.

Incident Logs are being used and included the parents' signature.

Attendance records are complete. When afterschoolers got off the Preschool Centre Bus, some parents were at the centre waiting for their children. Educators then conducted another headcount and confirmed children who were present. All children washed hands before having snack.

Snack time was observed. Educators ensured the tables were thoroughly cleaned and had napkins and food prepared for when the second group of afterschoolers arrived. Snack today was goldfish and bananas.

Many children are interested in making Perler Bead designs. Other creations were in the kitchen that had been made on different days. The educators iron them so the children can take their designs home.

The transition from snack to choosing centers was smooth. Educators say, "Hocus Pocus" and children reply, "Everyone Focus." Children were able to vote for doing indoor or outdoor time first. Children washed hands again after snack. Educators wiped down the table and swept the floor.
