General Comments						
Upon Licensing staff arrival, the children were finishing up their lunch and playing outdoors. The outdoor play space had a variety of activities on the go. Children were observed playing gaga ball, using the mud kitchen, playing with a large connect four game on the deck space, as well as drawing. It is recommended that a second picnic table be added for additional seating space for outdoor snacks and lunch as some of the children were observed sitting on the ground.  The indoor space was organized and inviting. Rooms were tidy with twinkle lights and elements of nature incorporated throughout. Play material such as doll houses with accessories, Lego, art supplies, boardgames, science exploration, and books were in good condition. During inspection, the Administrator/Educator asked to use the landing at the top of the stairs as a cozy corner. School aged children are permitted to break away into a small group provided that the Educators know at all times where children are and frequently check on them. As discussed, please add a large mirror on the wall mid-way up the stairs as it will allow visual supervision from the ground floor. Please note that this adjustment in supervision is only to be used to the landing at the top of the stairs and not the additional rooms on the second level.  Child and staff files were verified, and all documents were in order. Monthly fire drills, daily attendance records and playground checks are being completed and recorded. The parent board in the main entry was organized and children's belongings were tidy with hooks and their names. Educators were actively engaged with the children and positive child guidance was observed.  Licensing staff recommends for renewal pending fire inspection.
