Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. The first aid course was completed on May 13, and proof of training is on file.

Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. The fence has not yet been installed in the after-school playground, but the materials have been purchased. Installation is expected to be completed by the end of August. During my visit, the preschool-aged children were not using the after-school playground. In the meantime, while awaiting the installation of the fence, they are using the fenced playground.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Jun 26, 2026	Jun 23, 2026
Comments: Deficiency is now compliant Gravel has been added as a protective surfacing material beneath the stationary equipment. Regular raking is required to ensure that the protective surface remains safe and effective.			

General Comments
A follow-up inspection was conducted on August 18, 2026. The required staff-to-child ratio was maintained during my visit. I observed outdoor play activities, and several groups had gone for walks in the neighbourhood. The required professional development hours have been completed by the educators concerned. Once the fence is installed in the after-school playground for use by preschool-aged children, a photograph may be submitted as confirmation. Licence renewal is recommended.
