General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on October 27, 2021, the children were playing outside on the playground.

General Comments

The children went indoors to have snack and create a Halloween craft before going into the gym to play. The educators were observed interacting with the children at their level and using positive child guidance techniques when needed.

On the day of the licensing inspection, licensing staff went over how to fill out the playground maintenance checklist. Please ensure that the monthly checklist is completed each month. In addition to the monthly checklist being completed each month, please conduct a daily safety check of the playground before the children play on the playground as the playground is used by the community when the children are not present. When licensing staff brought this to the attention of the educator she conducted the playground maintenance monthly check while licensing staff was still on site.

On the day of the licensing inspection, licensing staff noted that a purposefully planned program was not on site. An educator relayed to licensing staff that the plan is on her computer but she did not have the computer with her on the day of the inspection visit. The educator relayed to licensing staff that the children are participating in all things Halloween this week.

When licensing staff entered the school-aged indoor play space, licensing staff noted that a portable heater was being used to warm up the space. Portable heaters pose to be a safety hazard. Please ensure that portable heaters are not used to warm up the classroom and if the classroom is not warm enough, please inform maintenance to turn up the heat so that the children and staff stay warm. When this was brought to the attention of the educator she removed the heater from the indoor play space.

The stationary equipment located ton he outdoor play space does not meet the recommended depth. Please replenish the pea gravel to the manufacture's recommended depth according to the manufacturer's manual or Canada's Consumer Product Safety Act.

When licensing staff was conducting the licensing renewal inspection, she noted that the closet that contains the cleaning supplies was unlocked. Please ensure that the cleaning supplies are locked up at all times to ensure the safety of the children. When this was brought to the attention of the Program Coordinator she locked the closet immediately.
