General Comments
<p>Many new changes since my last visit.</p> <p>They have created a private parent Facebook group to stay connected with parents and share information and photos. A new newsletter has also been created.</p> <p>The parent board has been updated and now contains all required information. I would recommend that a copy of the newsletter also be posted on the parent board.</p> <p>Both rooms have been cleaned and reorganized. They received donations and so there is added supplies and materials in both rooms.</p>

General Comments

The sofas can now be used by the children and so they created a quiet area with puzzles and games where children can sit and socialize.

The broken swings were removed so children cannot use them. The climbing/slide structure has not been repaired and so the children cannot use it until it's repaired.

The protective surfacing under the climbing dome will need to be re-inspected in the spring once the snow is gone.

The children arrived around 2:20 pm and were asked to wash their hands before playing and eating snack. Positive child guidance was observed such as gentle reminders about washing their hands or sitting when eating. While having snack, one of the educators was engaged in conversation with the children talking about their favorite snack and talking to another child about his birthday. The same educator started a game where she drew some pictures on the whiteboard and the children guessed what it was, then the children took over the drawing and continued the game among each other.

A reminder, no hot beverages where children are present.

I recommend for renewal.
