General Comments
<p>Upon arrival at the licensed facility, licensing staff was screened for Covid-19.</p> <p>The indoor play environments throughout the centre were very welcoming and inviting. All educators were observed engaged with the children whether putting them down for their nap or playing a game or activity with the children.</p> <p>The children were seen laughing, playing and engaging in play with their educators and peers.</p> <p>While reviewing staff files, licensing staff noted that all required documents were located in the files.</p> <p>While licensing staff was observing in the junior infant room, it was noted that food items in the fridge were not labelled with the child's name. When this was brought to the attention of the operator she went to label the items but the children had already consumed the items. The operator is aware now that all food items belonging to the children need to be labelled.</p>

General Comments

During nap time, licensing staff inspected the outdoor play environments and noted that on the infant play space there were two pieces of equipment that were cracked and damaged. When licensing staff brought this to the attention of the operator she removed the damaged items from the play space.

Licensing staff also noted that the tires located on the infant play ground had standing water inside the rim of the tire. Please drill holes in the rim to allow for drainage of water to ensure the safety of the children.

While inspecting the both the preschool and infant outdoor play space, licensing staff noted that the pea rock is packed down. Please rake up the pea rock and once raked up, please measure the pea rock to determine that it measures for the appropriate depth around the stationary equipment and meets the recommended depth according to the manufacturers' manual or the Canadian Consumer Product Safety Act.
