Educators were able to demonstrate that they are planning activities for the children and some are following the curriculum framework well. However, in other rooms there is still a disconnect from child led activities. For example, in one of the younger rooms, the children were painting and the educator was showing them how and where to put the marks of paint. There was also a concern for paint going off the brown paper and onto the table. Licensing staff spoke with the administrator and it was determined that support from the curriculum team for programming in some groups would be favorable.							
Educators were seen interacting with the children by having meaningful conversations, being at their level and playing with the children.
