General Comments							
Upon arrival, some of the children were having snack while others were playing freely. The classrooms are set up with learning centres such as dramatic play, blocks, cars, sensory, art, books. As discussed, please continue to build the resources and materials in the classrooms that are lacking. It is to my understanding that educators are struggling with materials going missing or getting broken. It is important that the engagement with children is happening as learning opportunities to show the children to properly care for materials both indoors and outdoors.  The administrator stated that new resources have been ordered for the outdoor play space. I made a suggestion to one of the educators that invitations for play, also be set up on the picnic tables. These materials can be brought outside from inside. There are structures such as easles and little houses that could be accessorized and set up as a learning centres. Educators will have to work collaboratively to make this happen.  Since last inspection, the curriculum framework is more evident in all the classrooms. Educators are providing more open-ended activities and are planning a program based on the children's interests. At the time of visit, I observed the senior infant class painting. The educators let them explore with paint and did not mind that it was messy. Also, documentation of the children's learning was posted throughout the facility in the form of learning stories, pictures, homemade children's books, and scrap books to name a few. The children's artwork could be observed on the bathroom wall, infant nap room, classrooms and hallways.  Files are kept in a meticulous manner. They are organized and complete. I was able to verify all documentation for licensing.
