<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 10:30am. Upon arrival, the children in all classrooms were engaged in free play activities. The 2/3-year old's classroom were observed having a "dance party" the children were dancing to music while holding and playing with balloons. The educators had lowered the lights and had a multicolored light flashing around the classroom. The educators were observed singing and dancing with the children. One educator was observed kneeling to be on the same level as the children to speak to them. As the children named other songs they wanted to dance to, the educators were observed queueing up the songs. Another educator was observed setting out coloring materials and sat down to color with a group of children.</p> <p>In the infant classroom, the educator was observed helping the children eat their morning snacks. The educator was observed sitting on the floor while supervising the children as they ate. After eating, the educator was observed washing the children's hands and inviting them to engage in free play activities such as playing with sensory balls and trucks. During this time, the 3/4-year-old classroom was observed transitioning inside. The educators encouraged the children to properly store their personal belongings and use the washroom if they needed to. The educators were observed helping the children get undressed and were heard praising them. The children were invited to gather on a carpet to read a book before lunch time. Some children chose to engage in free play activities, and the educators respected their choices.</p> <p>The educators in all classrooms were observed preparing the children's lunches. The children were supervised at all times while they ate. The educators were heard encouraging the children to remain seated while eating and praised the children for eating. The children's water bottles were offered during the meal, and the educators offered more food to the children as they finished. Other educators were observed preparing the children's beds for nap time. After eating, the children's diapers were changed, and the lights were lowered for nap time. The educators were on touch with the children's needs, documentation and learning stories were posted in the indoor environment. Pictures of the children's families, arts and crafts and pictures of the children while at play were present in all classrooms.</p>
