If the child doesn't have a medical practitioner at the moment, the parent can complete this section by mentioning that they are on a waiting list. The operator must make shure that all child files are complete.

Comments: 2 out of 2 water bottles were not labelled with the name of the child. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The operator immediately labeled the water bottles. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: 2 lunch box is not identified. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. Operator immediately place the name on the bag. Deficiency is now compliant.
