Licensing staff had a conversation with the site supervisor on how this was a missed play experience for the child. Site supervisor informed licensing staff that they have a child who, dumps all of the water out of the bins. Site supervisor, educators, and inclusion support workers to come up with a plan to keep the water table filled and open for all children to have free choice of play experiences.

Site supervisor to go over child positive guidelines with pre-school educators. One educator observed shrugging their shoulders at a child who became visibly upset. Educator left the child under the lego table crying. Licensing staff spoke to site supervisor. Site supervisor to go over child positive guidelines with pre-school educators.			

General Comments
<p>A renewal inspection occurred today.</p> <p>Pre-school children and school age children were observed both in the inside and outside environments.</p> <p>Pre-school children were observed playing with playdough, lego, stringing beads onto pipe cleaners, painting, coloring, and playing dress-up. Educators were observed spread out in the classroom, allowing proper supervision of all children. Educators were observed playing with the children. Ongoing nature documentation was displayed in the classroom that reflects the children's current learning.</p> <p>After-School Room One: Children were observed playing darts, lego, messy play with flour, and in the dramatic play center coffee shop. Educators were observed playing with the children. Licensing staff had conversations with the educators about adding more documentation and pictures of the children around the room.</p> <p>After-School Room Two: Children were observed making rings out of pipe cleaners, using scratch art, doing puzzles, and playing with some new materials that the educator recently added to the room such as: Suction cups and bead puzzles. Educators were observed playing with the children.</p>

General Comments

Wow butter, crackers, granola bars, and bananas were served for snack and chicken soup with crackers was served for lunch. Children were observed having seconds. Licensing staff had a conversation with school-aged educators about snack being an invitation/ choice for the children.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of child files was completed.

Operator to ensure that all pre-school staff have completed the required 10 hours of professional learning by the end of January.

Recommending all preschool educators and inclusion support workers review diaper changing procedures.
