Comments: Outdoor fenced in play area - two areas of fencing unsafe. Main gate has a gap, between brick wall and gate. This gap is big enough for a child to escape. To the right of the main gate, there is a section of fencing that is pushed up. Because of it being pushed up, a child could escape under the fence.  District has been contacted, and someone will be visiting the school, to assess the fencing situation. Educators, Support Workers, etc. to monitor these areas. Educators stated that someone from the district had recently been out to observe these areas.  Original comply by date: October 4, 2024.

General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection was conducted this morning. Children were observed during inside and outside play. Upon arrival, children were observed taking part in a variety of inside activities - painting, drawing, building with Lego, playing dress up, and looking at big books. The Arts &amp; Crafts area was well stocked - paper, different colored felt, pencil crayons, markers, glue, scissors, paint, etc. The Dramatic Play area was organized - kitchen, kitchen accessories, grocery store, babies, baby accessories, and dress up clothing. The reading area had several books on display, and there were big, new books, that had recently been added. Documentation - several forms of documentation were observed - children's open-ended artwork, photos of the children taking part in activities, a family wall, and a documentation binder for each child.</p> <p>Outside - fresh mulch had recently been added to the play yard. The rusty, metal remnants of an old play piece had been removed, and newer picnic benches had replaced the ones that were previously there.</p> <p>While outside, children were observed playing basketball, kicking balls, and playing catch. Children were also observed swinging and playing on the equipment. Positive Child Guidance Techniques were observed - Educators taking part in play, educators singing with the children, and educators offering choices.</p>
