These items must be locked and inaccessible to children. Products were moved to a locked closet during the renewal inspection. Deficiency is now compliant.

<p>COVID-19 Recovery phase: Guidance to Early Learning and Childcare Facilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inspector was fully screened for COVID-19 before entering the facility. Group logs, screening documents, operational plan, household logs and cleaning schedules are accessible in the centre. In relation to the cleaning and disinfecting schedule, Inspector suggests identifying who is responsible to complete each task and once task is complete having the staff initial stating task has been completed. - Inspector also had a discussion with the operator about having household logs in an area that makes it quick to access if needed. - While social distancing was visible between groups inspector reminded the operator that in common areas if social distance is not possible mask should be worn when educators meet other groups. <p>During time of inspection, Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and children. Purposely planned programming and documentation were visible in all classroom. Each group enjoyed the</p>
