General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at Forest Park Childcare to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. The indoor environment was clean, organized and welcoming. The children were engaged in free play, some dancing to music while others were observed playing with musical instruments. The Operator sat with the children and sang several songs before reading a Halloween themed book. After the story, a child asked the Operator if they could do yoga. The group was observed doing multiple yoga poses with the Operator.

Later in the morning the children put paint shirts on as they prepared to paint pumpkins. The Operator allowed the children to pick their own pumpkin and chose which color paint they would like. The Operator encouraged them to open the paint bottles by themselves and squeeze some onto their plate, offering assistance if needed. As the children finished painting their pumpkins, hands were washed and the group started to prepare to go outside for a walk in the neighborhood. The children walked to a nearby open space with a large dirt pile. The children laughed as they jumped in puddles, climbed up the large pile of dirt and looked at different leaves on the ground. The transition back to the facility for lunch was smooth. Once back inside, the children hung up their outdoor gear, washed their hands and brought their lunch to the table.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Operator spoke kindly and respectfully when interacting with the children. The Operator encourages independence, however, stays close by and offers support and assistance when needed. The indoor environment was well-organized with a variety of resources and materials, all on low, open shelves. The room had a bookshelf next to a play couch, with various books, all in good condition. The children's artwork is posted throughout, as well as family pictures and learning stories.
