General Comments

Upon arrival I noticed a difference in the environment. The Operator added more defined early learning centres in the room that the children play in. This included but was not limited to books, a kitchen area, dress up clothes, art and a cozy area.

The Operator uses a weekly planner to document activities that she is doing with the children. Each child also has a scrap book documenting open ended art and photos in it. The children's words, phrases and quotes are documented as the operator hears them.

The activities that the children have been involved in the past months included but are not limited to; planting and harvesting, painting with flowers, tasting new foods, having sessions with the Talk with Me program, and having a visit with Oromocto Fire. It is evident that the Operator likes to incorporate new experiences and activities to guide the children's learning.

At the park learning continued and this is where another Early Learning and Childcare Home joined this Operator. A book about Fall was read to the children allowing them to have a good discussion about experiences that the children had apple picking, going to a pumpkin patch, their preferences in the kinds of apples that they like to eat and any trips that they have had with their families. An action song about pumpkins followed and then the children proceeded to go on a walk. There were 4 leaf bags put out for the children with 4 different colored leaves attached to them. The children were going to find leaves of the same color to put in the bags.

The Operator is continually engaged with the children, providing an environment that is nurturing and educational.

The filing system that the operator now uses is much more organized and complete than previous years. I was able to verify all documentation required for licensing.

I can now recommend facility for licensing.
