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**General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived at Dawson Day Home to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were in the process of changing into bathing suits to prepare to play outside. While the children waited for their peers to change, they were eager to show Licensing Staff their Floor Book. It was a large scrapbook filled with pictures, quotes from the children, drawings and learning stories. Once all the children had changed, they got their outdoor shoes and hats on and transitioned outside.

The Operator explained another home was joining them for some outdoor activities today. The Operator set up a tuff tray with green and yellow Oobleck, plastic frogs, crocodiles, lily pads, rocks and flowers. The Operator also set up a table with chart paper, paint pucks, a variety of paint brushes, paint rollers and water. Throughout the morning the group engaged with the activities that were set up. Children were also observed playing in the sandbox and playing T-Ball. When it was time to clean up for lunch time, the children worked together to put all the plastic animals into a bin before putting their pinnies on and lining up to go to the park. The children got their bookbags, and the Operator brought their wagon which had the first aid kit and play materials for the park.

Several headcounts were observed as the group walked along a path to a nearby public park. Once the group arrived, they used the washrooms and washed their hands for lunch. The Operator placed a large blanket on the grass for the children to sit on as they ate. The Operator was observed offering assistance with containers and lunch boxes before sitting down to read "Knuffle Bunny" while the children ate their lunch. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection.
