#### General Comments

Completed follow up to renewal inspection today. All orders for compliance have been rectified. The new play kitchen that was ordered has not yet arrived. The current kitchen poses no safety concern. it is just missing the doors.

The room was set up with inviting materials, positioned on low open shelves for the children to explore. Books have been positioned in a way that invites the children to read. Educators were observed reading with the children. Lunch time and diapering routines were also observed.

The children are currently exploring babies and farm animals, which was evident based on materials and equipment that have been added t the environment. Educators were eager to share current documentation demonstrating these interests and what the children are learning.

Recommending licence for renewal.
