General Comments

Educators walk over across the street to pick up the children after school. For the grades 3-5 dismissal, if there is a group that stays behind at the facility, educators ensure ratio is always met and never leave more than 15 children behind with one educator. Should they be over 15, the "over" number of children walk over to the school with the other educator to get the grades 3-5 children after school.

When I arrived for today's monitoring inspection, a small group of children were applying sunscreen to go get some fresh air. Educator ensured all children applied sunscreen and had their water bottle filled. The area the children went to play in was fully shaded and had a nice breeze, children were observed exploring the trees and just hanging out with one another. The group only stayed outside for 10-15 minutes, then returned inside.

As a reminder, please ensure all educators are familiar with the temperature guidelines for children playing outside, which is Regulation 22(a)(i-iii) and can be found in section 7.2 "Daily Routine" in the Operator Manual.

Once inside, all children were able to play freely around the main room. Children were observed playing at a variety of different stations, such as arts/crafts, reading, building/Lego, playing cards and also playing indoor soccer.

There was a group of children that were keen on organizing their own active game. Educator was very happy to let them organize their game themselves, but ensure she stayed nearby in case there were any disputes. Children decided on playing a game of soccer. The ball they were using was a bit deflated, educators and manager went to pump it up but realized the pump was broken. Manager stated she will have a new pump delivered ASAP. Children were still observed happily playing soccer at time of visit. Educators were both quick to act when they saw children who required assistance throughout the visit.
