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General Comments

On the day of my visit the children were gathered together to hear a guest Author read two of her books, *Never Wake a Sleeping Nannie* and *You Can Have Mine*. The children were engaged with the stories and there were lots of interactive opportunities where children could ask questions and find the Lady Bugs hidden on each page in the first book and the Dragonflies hidden on each page in the second book. When the story was finished the author gave the children stickers of Lady Bugs and the Educators an autographed copy of each book.

The children then prepared for outside play. The weather forecast was for heavy rain in the afternoon, and the children were eager to be outside before it started. Staff took their first aid kits, attendance sheets and the children's water bottles outside and there were also outside toys in a trunk in the play area like shovels, hockey sticks and containers. Today the children played in the smaller play area, and it had a dome climber, another climber with two slides and plastic climbing tires. The children really enjoyed their outside play time, and the educators joined them in their imaginative games.

All administrative tasks were up to date, child and staff files verified, play area checks were completed, and fire drills were done and recorded every month. The center was clean and organized and really well arranged for the children's play. The cozy corner in the reading station was especially nice, as it is on a raised platform that separates it a bit from the rest of the room and the other kinds of play.

All the educators used positive child guidance. They were kind and patient with the children and interested in their conversations, comments and their play. The atmosphere was calm and positive with smooth transitions and a calm nap time.
