General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including painting, gross motor play indoors, dramatic play, outdoor play and fine motor activities. Each learning environment is set up with a variety of materials and invitations for the children to explore. A small group of children were observed creating and exploring with loose parts in the Fours Room.

Documentation is displayed throughout the environments that supports the children's current interests (doctor, dinosaurs, babies and family) and includes connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.

After recommendations left by the QA Monitor at the last Monitoring Inspection that staff have switched two environments. The Three/Fours are now in the learning environment with two washrooms and the Fours are now in the learning environment with one washroom. This recommendation was left to support staff and children with toilet training as two washrooms would be accessible to the Three/Fours. The administrator states that this
