Monitoring Inspection:

QA Monitor quickly followed up on orders for compliance left at previous inspection in Infant Rooms this morning. Infants were observed exploring their learning environment freely. Invitations are set-up throughout the environment for the infants to explore.

Diaper changing procedures were observed to be followed. Handwashing routines were observed.

Monitoring Inspection with focus on After-School Program was conducted this afternoon.

The school-age children and staff were engaged in a variety of activities including mark making, fine motor activities, dramatic play and painting. Purposeful planning is evident through documentation on planning sheets and through materials and invitations added to the environment.

Handwashing routines observed at arrival from school and before snack.
Homemade muffins and berries were served for afternoon snack.
New staff file (2) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
