Comments: Quality Assurance monitor was informed by the administrator of several cases of vomiting and diarrhea in the facility. However, a notice to inform the parents was not posted. A notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease must be posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. Administrator immediately posted it on the facility door and classroom doors. Deficiency is now compliant

Quality Assurance monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.

During the visit the following elements were observed.

- storage space for toxic products, cleaning supplies and chemical products.
- documents that need to be posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- Indoor play area materials and equipment
- certain staff members' files

During the monitoring inspection, QA monitor was able to observe indoor play. Children also had the chance to enjoy the outdoors.
