Renewal inspection completed today.

Children were engaged in play in their learning environments and making use of their breakout space for gross motor activities.

Materials available included puzzles, games, art materials, dramatic play, blocks, Lego, marble works. Breakout space provided opportunities for gross motor play as well as quiet activities (Games and art).

Educators were observed to engage with children in activities, supporting their efforts through conversation while sitting alongside them.

Use of programming sheets highlights materials and activities offered to children. A documentation binder with photos and captions of activities children have completed demonstrates that educators are observing the

children's process and their responses to activities. Making this binder accessible to the children also offers opportunities to revisit favorite activities or expand on past experiences.
As discussed during inspection, incident logs are to be filed chronologically in a folder or binder and not filed in children's files.
