A Monitoring Inspection occurred today on June 7, 2024, in the afternoon.					
During the inspection, children were observed transitioning indoors and engaging in free play. Proper handwashing practices were noted as the children moved inside. Sunscreen and drinking water is provided throughout the day. Educators reported that the children are currently very interested in outdoor activities and playing board games inside. The educators were seen using positive language and providing gentle reminders to the children.					
The facility maintains all required records and documents for a year, and parents are informed of incidents through completed incident report forms in the event of reportable incidents. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted. The license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and compliance orders are all displayed in a clearly visible and prominent location. Evacuation procedures are also posted prominently. Parents and children are greeted with enthusiasm upon arrival at the facility, which is well-equipped with a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. The facility features several well-defined learning centers, including areas for building, reading, and dramatic play.  The curriculum offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences, with various forms of literacy present in the indoor environment. Numerous forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility, indicating a comprehensive and structured approach to education and care.
