### General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on March 13, 2025.

Children were observed during both indoor and outdoor free play. Proper handwashing was observed during the transition from outside to inside. Educators noted that children are currently very engaged in outdoor activities, creating a hat shop with paper hats, making beaded jewelry, building with LEGO, constructing a giant box fort, and designing leprechaun traps using cardboard and upcycled materials. Educators were observed using positive language and providing gentle reminders. Outdoors, educators played an active role in children's activities, supporting and engaging in their play.

The facility maintains a daily incident log, and parents are informed of incidents. Incident report forms are completed for reportable incidents. Parents of children attending the center are granted entry at any time. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted. A clearly visible and prominent space is designated for posting the license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. The daily routine is displayed, evacuation procedures are posted in a prominent location, and life-threatening allergies are clearly documented.

Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, with several pieces of children's artwork displayed throughout the facility. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways remain free of clutter. Toxic products, including chemical cleaners, are locked away and inaccessible to children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day. Programming offers opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Children are encouraged to express creativity, explore the arts and sciences, experience accomplishments, problem-solve, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships.
