materials that were age appropriate, down at the children's level, and open and ready for all children to explore throughout the day.

Documentation and pictures of the children were displayed around the room in each classroom environment. This allows children to revisit their previous play experiences. Licensing staff discussed with the administrators how they could take their documentation to the next level. This would be done by referencing the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework and planning what's next to scaffold the children's learning.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, daily attendance sheets, and infant toddler daily sheets.
