<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing arrived at the facility to conduct a monitoring visit. In the larger classroom the children were moving from station to station and engaging in different Montessori activities that they refer to as their work. One of the educators had her group in the smaller room and was doing small group language work. The facility teaches many core skills and cursive writing is one. The children's writing books were very lovely to see, and they seemed to enjoy this activity. The room also had a carpet where other children were constructing things with various types of blocks, lego and at the tables some children were playing Jenga and one child was knitting/looming a nest with a manual knitting machine.</p> <p>In the larger room the children had various workstations set up for cleaning, bells to compare sound and to play songs on, measuring, tracing at the light table, and a large carpet to make a maze with or compare measuring rods. There was also an ellipse on the floor in masking tape and a reading corner for circle. Today at circle time the educator read "Now Wash Your Hands" by Matt Carr. Everyone was very engaged with this book and discussed germs and learned new words such as contagious and emulsifying. The children's learning was very self-directed, and they followed their interests during the morning programming. There was also a strong emphasis on courtesy and the educators modelled kind, courteous, and respectful interactions amongst themselves and the children. Children are encouraged to problem solve conflict peacefully together and there was a peace rose and book set up to help further demonstrate how this could be done.</p> <p>Everyone was preparing for a Mother's Day Art show and the children had also painted pots and planted tomatoes to give to their Moms. The children had lunch and then everyone went outside for outside play. They have a separate fenced in and gated preschool play area set up just for them.</p> <p>Licensing staff reviewed staff files and 6 children's files, and everything was up to date and complete.</p>
