<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Infant Room: Children engaged in play both indoors and outdoors this morning. Educators observed to be down at the children's level to play in the sand outside. Documentation is posted throughout the room that highlights the children's learning and experiences. Educators include a link to the NB Curriculum Framework within their documentation. The children are currently interested in dumping and filling and their new pet fish. How can you expand on these interests? What materials, documentation and invitations could be added to the environment to support the interest? Discussed with educators ways to start incorporating the use of the table and chairs for this age group. Diaper changing procedures were followed this morning. Hand washing routines were observed.</p> <p>Preschool: Children and educators observed engaged in a game of Hide and Seek outdoors this morning. The educators have added science materials on a shelf within the learning environment for the children to explore. These materials are set up in a way that is inviting and includes materials from nature. Educators observed sitting with the children during snack and engaging in conversations. Documentation is posted throughout the room that highlights the children's learning, interests and experiences. Discussed with educators ways to encourage children to take care of books. Displaying books throughout the room and discussing how to care for books with the children will help alleviate book damage.</p>
