Comments: One staff file missing Criminal Record Check. Vulnerable sector check was in file however, the second page that includes the Criminal Record Check was not on file. Discussed with staff during inspection.

Comments: The thermostat reading within the preschool room (basement) at time of inspection was 14 degrees celsius. This is too cold and not comfortable for the children and educators. Operator to consult with public health for proper heating requirements and temperature must be maintained while children are present. Discussed with staff during inspection.			
29 An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that the traffic area and the outdoor walk-ways of the licensed facility are free from obstructions and hazards.	29	Dec 21, 2022	
Comments: Fire exit (back of building) snow and ice covered. QA Monitor brought to administrator's attention during inspection, as immediate attention is required. Snow and ice must be removed from fire exit before children arrive for the day.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Jan 23, 2023	
Comments: Toddler Room (Upstairs): Dramatic Play Kitchens (2) - sinks accumulating dust and debris. To be cleaned. Dramatic play area - unorganized. Bins to be labeled and sorted. This area is to be set up in a way that invites children to engage in play. Baby dolls - unclean and stained. To be cleaned or replaced.			

General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

Children and educators engaged in a variety of activities this morning including story, songs and outdoor play. Educators observed engaging in conversations with children at their level.

Documentation is posted throughout each environment that supports children's learning, experiences and interests. Documentation includes photos of the children and connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Discussed with staff and administrator the use of pre-cut crafts. These are not examples of open-ended art opportunities. Art opportunities to be open-ended moving forward. A variety of materials, paper and mark making tools to be accessible to children, that allow them to choose freely and explore their individual creativity.
