General Comments

Upon my arrival the children were playing with different toys and doing different learning activities and had already spent part of the morning outside. An invitation for play was set up shortly upon my arrival with art supplies and books about pumpkins.

The centre is clean and organized. There are different materials to meet the children's different interests and learning needs. There are blocks, books, pretend play items such as a kitchen and kitchen equipment and also some puzzles and other loose parts. There is also a sensory bin made of leaves, wood and pinecones with a book to go along with it.

There is a change in the way the curriculum is offered. They have moved to a child led curriculum which is in line with the NB Curriculum Framework. The site Leader shared positive feedback regarding the change.

There is evidence of purposely planned programming. The centre uses a web format with the input of the children to guide their programming. The curriculum is emergent, based on the time of year and changes with the children's interests. This is also in line with the NB Curriculum Framework.

The children were encouraged to clean up together using a cleanup song. All the children participated, and the children were provided with stickers for helping.

Positive child guidance was observed such as positive reinforcement and encouragements during clean up time and gentle reminders when children were observed being too rough or throwing toys and were asked if they needed help instead. They also provided options as they had three different activities set up on the tables plus all the other stations.

The centre also promotes an environment that encourages positive behavior by arranging the environment so children can move freely between learning centres, they involve the children by giving them responsibilities and letting them help and also by preparing the children for transitions. They were observed giving children warnings before transition periods and using songs. The educators were also observed using positive language when interacting with the children, saying please and thank you and talking to the children using a calm and respectful

tone.

Around 11:25 the children did circle time; they sang a song together about the days of the week. Then had lunch around 11:45.

Around 12:05 the afterschool educators walked over to the school to get the children. The afterschool children arrived around 12:30, had lunch outside and then went on a field trip.

Everything is in compliance; I recommend for renewal.
