<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the preschool program to make a monitoring visit. The children were just beginning their snack time and preparing for morning circle. As children finished eating they would choose a book and go to the reading corner to await those who were taking longer to finish. This created a smooth transition for the group. The theme this week is the farm, and the sensory table was set up with farm animals, a nest and eggs and other theme related items. There was a good assortment of materials such as plastic bugs and a magnifying glass, a ball pit, large foam/rubber blocks, a dramatic play area, dolls and doll house, blocks, lego, dolls markers, crayons and paper to name a few. After circle the children choose activities that were set up at the tables such as tracing words with markers and farm animals etc. Clean up and preparing for outside play went smoothly and this preschool group used the outdoor play area furthest away from the center.</p> <p>The educators ensured that the children had their water bottles and they helped them put on sunscreen. It was hot and sunny, and the cloth shade has been put up on all the outdoor play areas. There was a large climber and chalk, balls and containers were available to the children. The teachers were organized and proactive with the children helping them solve disputes with each other and negotiate play. They were kind and patient and genuinely interested and engaged with the children.</p> <p>The group came in for lunch, washed hands and ate and cots were set up for some of the children in the far end of the room to nap. The rest of the group played in the same room, but this did not disrupt the children who napped.</p> <p>Staff and child files were verified, and the parent board, fire drills and cleaning lists were all up to date. The afterschool program associated with this license was not observed today.</p>
