Comments: 6 children files out of 12 audited are missing either 1 emergency contact and telephone number or the complete address of the emergency contact. Operator must have the file completed before the children begins at the facility.

Comments: A bottle of Tums, and vitamins was on the operator desk. All medication must be locked and inaccessible to children. Operator did lock the medication in cabinet by key. Deficiency is now compliant.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Jul 31, 2024	
Comments: Several children water bottles are not labeled with their names. Operator must ensure that all personal objects are identified.

Comments: Several lunch bags or containers are not identified or refrigerated as required. Operator must ensure that the lunch bags or containers are properly identified and refrigerated if required.
