Comments:	mments: During a follow-up inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed the operator leaving all nine children unsupervised in the gym area while the operator went to the main play area/office to search for the child attendance record. After several minutes, the operator returned to the gym area.			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct a third follow-up inspection.

Deficiency is now compliant

Upon arrival, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed two new staff members present with four children. When asked to present their staff files, the individuals appeared unsure of what was being requested. The Quality Assurance Monitor inquired whether the staff had valid Criminal Record Checks, Vulnerable Sector Checks, and Social Development checks on file. One staff member stated they would contact the operator for clarification.

After the operator arrived on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor again requested the staff files. The operator confirmed that no files had been completed for the individuals in question. The operator stated that checks had been submitted to Social Development but had not yet been returned. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that this is the second occurrence of such a situation and reiterated that staff cannot be present on site without completed and cleared Criminal Record Checks, Vulnerable Sector Checks, and Social Development checks.

The operator explained that the staff were brought in due to a sudden staffing shortage and that one of the staff members was the operator's cousin who resides with them. The Quality Assurance Monitor emphasized that all staff—regardless of relationship or circumstance—must have the appropriate background checks in place prior to being on site.

Furthermore, the Quality Assurance Monitor advised the operator that in cases of staff shortages, families must be notified, and make arrangements for pick-up at school and drop off at daycare if necessary. The operator may also need to consider closing the facility temporarily until adequate staffing requirements are met in compliance with regulations.
