Children are not given the opportunity to choose games, toys and art materials from the shelving throughout the room. Children must be given time and space to choose from the wide variety of materials within the learning environment. It was stated that, the children from the junior group are brought downstairs to sit on the bench outside the senior room once attendance is lowered. These children are not given the opportunity for free choice as they are required to sit in the hall with books. Children are to be free to circulate their environment and be engage in activities for the duration of time they are attending the program. The children and educator have created two large board games together. They have worked together to create the characters, rules, game board and pawns. What a great opportunity for the children!

Junior Group (upstairs):

Children engaged in a variety of activities today. Invitations are set up for the children when they arrive from school. The bookshelf in the cozy area is full of quality age appropriate books. This is an inviting spot to curl up with a book!

A wide variety of materials are available within the environment however the children are not permitted to choose items from the shelving.
