General Comments
<p>Completed renewal inspection today. Screening procedures were implemented upon my arrival. Children were engaged in activities within their environment within both school aged rooms. Topics of interest were easily identified within both of the rooms. Currently, the junior school aged children are planting/growing beans, and showing an interest in creative art. Documentation of the children's learning was apparent around the room. Recommending that dates are recorded on documentation going forward. Each room was set up with age appropriate activities pertaining to the children's interests. Additional materials can be added to senior room (ex: additional creative art materials, other activities for the children to explore). There is a "teacher desk" set up with some materials/supplies within this room as well. What additional accessories could be added to this center to make it more inviting? The senior school aged children are currently interested in puzzles, sewing and evidence of this is displayed throughout the environment. Hand washing was observed upon arrival to program/prior to eating snack. Observed junior school aged children engaged in outdoor play during time of inspection. Lead on site reports that the playground equipment is not being used currently due to depleted pea gravel levels, but the children do use the climbing structure (spider structure), the paved area on the side of the building and the field. Group logs were observed and completed. One child who has a life threatening allergy will resume attending after school program this week. Ensure parent reviews Extreme Allergy Management Plan and signs off on any changes. Recommending to keep a copy of this within the child's file and also one with the child's Epipen. This child's Epipen is on site from last year but has since expired. Ensure parent is informed of this, and that a new one accompanies the child upon resuming program.</p>
