Comments: There was no evidence of purposeful planning, and no current documentation was observed in the classroom. Purposeful planning and documentation are required and should be present, reflecting the children's ongoing learning.

Comments: There were insufficient art materials available for the school-age children. Additional materials are to be added, such as paint, paintbrushes, modeling clay, playdough, stencils, sponges, watercolors, oil pastels, beads, yarn, fabric scraps, and other creative supplies to support a variety of art experiences and engagement.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.</p> <p>The children were observed outdoors playing on the stationary equipment, swinging on the swings, and engaging in a game of hockey. Educators indicated that the children are currently interested in hockey, drawing, coloring, and playing Bingo.</p> <p>Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products such as cleaning agents are securely locked and inaccessible to children.</p> <p>Positive child guidance techniques were observed. The educators were seen engaging at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using encouraging language, offering choices, and assisting children with decision making.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, a random review of child files, staff files, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.</p>
