General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor conducted a monitoring inspection on-site. Throughout the visit, the child-to-staff ratio was consistently maintained.

During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following:

- Information was posted in a visible and prominent location within the facility.
- Child guidance practices were observed.
- The outdoor play area was assessed, including its materials and equipment.
- Daily activities were reviewed.

Various types of play were observed during the monitoring inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed two infant groups playing outdoors while one infant group took a walk. Additionally, two and three-year-olds were engaged in outdoor play, while four-year-olds played indoors.

A discussion took place between the administrator and the Quality Assurance Monitor regarding allergy postings. The Quality Assurance Monitor inquired if there were any children with life-threatening allergies in the facility. The administrator confirmed the presence of an egg allergy and a peanut allergy, noting that parents had indicated these were not life-threatening. The administrator also confirmed that allergy information is posted in the kitchen, and the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that it was displayed in the children's classroom as well. Furthermore, the administrator stated that the facility is nut-free, and the Quality Assurance Monitor recommended placing a nut-free sign at the entrance.
