General Comments

Children were engaged in free play activities when I arrived. Materials are on low opened ended shelves that are easily accessible to the children. Each room has a picture of the children, and their families posted on the

It is recommended that lesson plans and learning stories be dated. There were two stories in the preschool room and three posted in the two-year-old room.

It is also recommended that the books in each room be sorted to make sure they are age- appropriate for the children. Also puzzles in the two-year old classroom are missing pieces. These puzzles need to be replaced. I would suggest that a different routine be implemented in the two-year old classroom. When the children come in from outside, hand washing and diaper changes should be done before the child starts to eat, not when the child is halfway through their meal. The would give the educators the opportunity to sit at the table with the children during lunch time.
