Comments: While observing the children in the indoor play environment, licensing staff noted the following: - crack fill along the door jam and, on the wall, in the infant room that needs to be sanded and then repainted to maintain the safety of the children. - chipped and flaking paint in the two-year-old classroom that will need to be sanded and repainted. - cluttered shelves in the infant and two-year-old classrooms that will need to be cleaned off to maintain the safety of the children as objects could fall off the shelves. - in the infant classroom there is duct tape holding on a splash plate located near the door that exits into the back yard that will need to be removed and adhere the splash plate to the wall with construction adhesive approved by Health Protection.

Comments: While observing the children in the outdoor play environment, licensing staff noted the following safety concerns and will need to be removed from the outdoor play environment: - a plastic pirate ship that is broken and has sharp edges and will need to be removed to maintain the safety of the children. - a large metal plane that is broken and has duct tape on a bar that is not connected to the frame of the plane and will need to be removed in order to maintain the safety of the children.

Comments: Licensing staff observed mark-making materials in the infant classroom however, the materials were being stored high on a shelf and not accessible to the children. Mark-making materials need to be accessible to the infants.			

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the License Renewal Inspection.

Licensing staff arrived as the infants were transitioning indoors from the outdoor play environment so the preschool and school-aged children to go outside to play.

When the infants got indoors the educator did diaper changes and washed the children up before engaging in free play activities.

Licensing staff observed the school-aged and preschool children while they were engaging in outdoor free play activities. Some children were playing on the stationary equipment while others played in the sandbox. When it was time to go inside and wash up for lunch, each group exited the outdoor play environment and lined up along the wall to ensure all children were accounted for and then made their way inside. Licensing staff observed educators counting numerous times to ensure they had all children in their group. Once indoors, the children went to the bathroom to wash up. After the children ate their lunch, those children who were going to nap, went onto their cots while other children played quietly.
