Comments: There was a child who had slipped and cut open his lip on the icy playground. The parent was called, child was taken to the hospital. The incident report was filled out but the incident was never reported to the Department. Educators were advised that an incident like this must be reported to the Department within 24 hours whether or not it has been signed by the parent or not. The incident report is to be signed by the parent upon return as it is my understanding that the child has not returned to facility due to illness since the accident.						
General Comments						
There have been many positive changes since the last renewal inspection. The classrooms are becoming more defined with learning centres and the educators are exposing the children to different kinds of learning. There was a big shift from more closed to open ended learning activities for the children seen at the time of visit.						
All educators were seen interacting with the children in a positive manner. They would talk and play with the children at their level. Also observed hugs and support when a child got hurt or was not feeling good.						
Staff were advised that they are to follow the guidelines for exclusion if they become sick too. For example, staff with fevers, vomitting, or diarrhea must be excluded as per guidelines.						
All documentation for licensing was complete and easily verified by licensing staff.						
It is necessary that the office / kitchen space be deep cleaned. There was quite a foul odour in that room on the day of visit. Cleanng would include washing out the garbage can, fridge, etc
