As per your quality improvement plan and licensing regulations you must implement a quality environment that is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present; easily accessible on low open shelves and arranged to allow opportunities for free choice of activities. Open ended materials and equipment must be in sufficient quantity and variety for the size of group and representative for each of the following categories must be present:

General Comments
-art materials including loose parts
-blocks and accessories
-dramatic play
-music and movement
-large muscle
-manipulatives and fine motor
-sand and water play
-puzzles and games
-materials that support mathematical learning
-materials that support learning in science and technology
Materials are not limited to use in a particular learning centre and the centres must be clearly defined.
There has been some material added to the environment; however, as stated above there are still requirements to meet licensing and designation requirements. It is to licensing's understanding that this facility has been following the 3-step support plan given by the curriculum team. All dates and recommendations must be followed and maintained going forward.
It is recommended that the example given by the curriculum team is used to show that the learning for the children is a process and initiated by them.
There is a noticeable difference in the learning environments in each area. There are more materials and areas set up and educators are now taking learning bins to the outdoor play space. Please continue to increase quality in each area by adding learning centres and offering a variety of materials for learning.
