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General Comments

A renewal inspection was conducted on the licensed childcare facility.

Upon arrival, licensing staff observed the children in the early learning room preparing for their morning snack alongside their educator. The children were enthusiastic and eager to share details about their snack as well as their plans for the day. Following snack time, licensing observed the children and educator participating in a morning meeting.

During the meeting, the educator encouraged the children to ask questions and express their thoughts and ideas about the two books that were read aloud. The discussion focused on themes of friendship, self-awareness, and self-acceptance. The children shared observations about what they see in a mirror and discussed the importance of loving and appreciating themselves.

Licensing accompanied the group on a visit to the Arts and Culture Park adjacent to the childcare facility. While outdoors, the children engaged in a variety of learning experiences, including mark-making activities using materials provided by the educator. The children also participated in imaginative play, embarking on a dragon hunt and a leprechaun hunt while music played in the background. In addition, the educator encouraged the children to collect leaves that had fallen from the trees to bring back to the early learning environment for further exploration and learning opportunities.

Prior to lunch, the children returned to the childcare facility with their educator. Handwashing routines were observed to occur consistently throughout the inspection. Children were engaged in constructive play with magnetic tiles and wooden blocks while the educator interacted alongside them on the floor. The educator actively supported the children's learning, play, and exploration by asking open-ended questions that encouraged critical thinking and expanded their knowledge and understanding.

Throughout the renewal inspection, licensing observed positive child guidance practices being implemented consistently by the educator.

The early learning facility is recommended for license renewal, pending the recommendation from Fire.
