## General Comments Requirements under Covid 19 recovery guide observed and in place. Hand washing observed during Monitoring Inspection. Ensure Group log date established reflects the date the "bubble" was created and not the current date unless a new child has joined the group.

Environments set up with materials and inviting for play. A balance of indoor and outdoor play occurred during monitoring inspection. The younger children's play space has improved significantly with the removal of the wall and is very inviting and engaging.

Recommending that younger children be provided with a table and chairs for meal times.

Younger group can now nap on mats or cots and do not require a pack n play.
