<p>General Comments</p> <p>Children and educators were enjoying play in the outdoor environment during today's monitoring inspection. Children were digging for worms, creating "salads" using grasses and leaves available, and playing in water play tables. Educators collaborated with children in their play, encouraging their efforts, asking open-ended questions, and getting down to their level to engage with them.</p> <p>Discussed with educators, requirements to ensure that purposeful planning is evident and that documentation of children's learning posted in the environment is current.</p> <p>Children's interests and learning should be present in the activities and materials that are available to them in both the indoor and outdoor environments. Today outdoors children were busy creating salads, offering drinks, and making sushi. How can you expand on this play? What materials, props, opportunities for math and literacy can you provide?</p> <p>Through observation of children in their play, favourite activities and materials, you can identify children's learning and interests. Those observations support how you plan your environment, what invitations you offer,</p>
