The administrator must ensure that the indoor play area is maintained clean. While on site, an administrator cleaned up the cupboard. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The inspector observed a round rusted metal with 2 holes in the toy bin. The administrator must ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and clean. While on site, an educator disposed of the round metal. Deficiency is now compliant
