Comments:	The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that 14 children were present, but more children were signed in on the attendance sheet. The educator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the children that are on the bus, on their way to the facility, are signed in. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminds the educator that only the children present at the facility must be signed in. With that, they must wait until the group arrives at the facility to sign them as present. The attendance sheet must be brought on the bus, or a different attendance sheet should be used during transportation. The attendance sheet is up to date before the QAM leaves the facility.
