Quality Assurance Monitor conducted a monitoring inspection to verify ratios, child guidance and administrative records; as well to drop off a copy of the NB Curriculum Framework documents. Observed the sod being installed in smaller outdoor play area during the inspection.
Observed positive interactions between staff and children. All staff were observed sitting at the children's level,

when infant's reached up for the educator, she responded by holding and comforting them. Preschool educator was observed engaging with the children as they played and being their conversational partners.
